**BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS**

is coming to St. Mary and St. Paul Parishes!

Carlo Acutis was a young Italian website designer who documented Eucharistic miracles and approved Marian apparitions, and then catalogued both on a website he designed before his death at age 15 from leukemia. Acutis was noted for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and devotion to the Eucharist, which became a core theme of his life. His canonization date will be announced July 1st.
