I am happy today to greet all of you at St. Augustine and St. Mary in the name of the Risen Lord Jesus!

As Archbishop, I have the important responsibility of providing you with ongoing pastoral care and sacramental ministry in your parish community.

As you know, I granted Father Paul Pluth's request to enter senior status beginning July 1, 2022. I am pleased to announce that, after consultation with the Priest Personnel Board, I have appointed Father Chris Hoiland as your new Pastor. Presently, Father Hoiland is the Priest Administrator at Christ the King Parish in Seattle.

Father Hoiland is a wonderful priest who will serve you and your parish with good faith and dedication. Be assured that he will receive all the support and assistance from the Archdiocese necessary to ensure quality pastoral care for your parish community.
