- 3. In .8 miles turn right onto Rocky Point Rd. and continue to the park.

#### Directions from St. Mary:

- 1. Go north on State Highway 20.
- 2. Turn left at Swantown Rd. (light)
- 3. In .4 miles turn right onto Heller Rd.
- 4. In 2.6 miles take second exit from roundabout onto W. Ault Field/Clover Valley Rd.
- 5. In .7 miles turn right onto Rocky Point Rd. and continue to the park.
