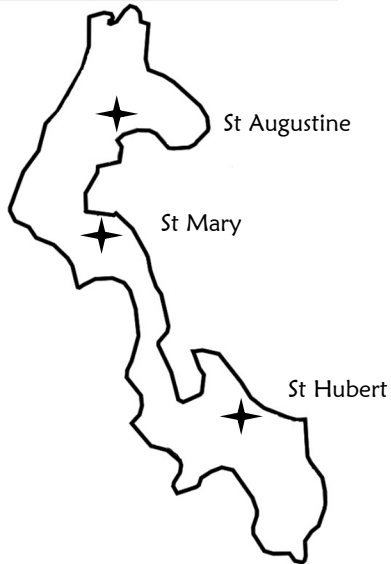

Prayer for Vocations

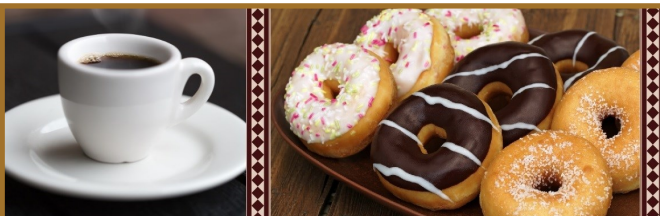

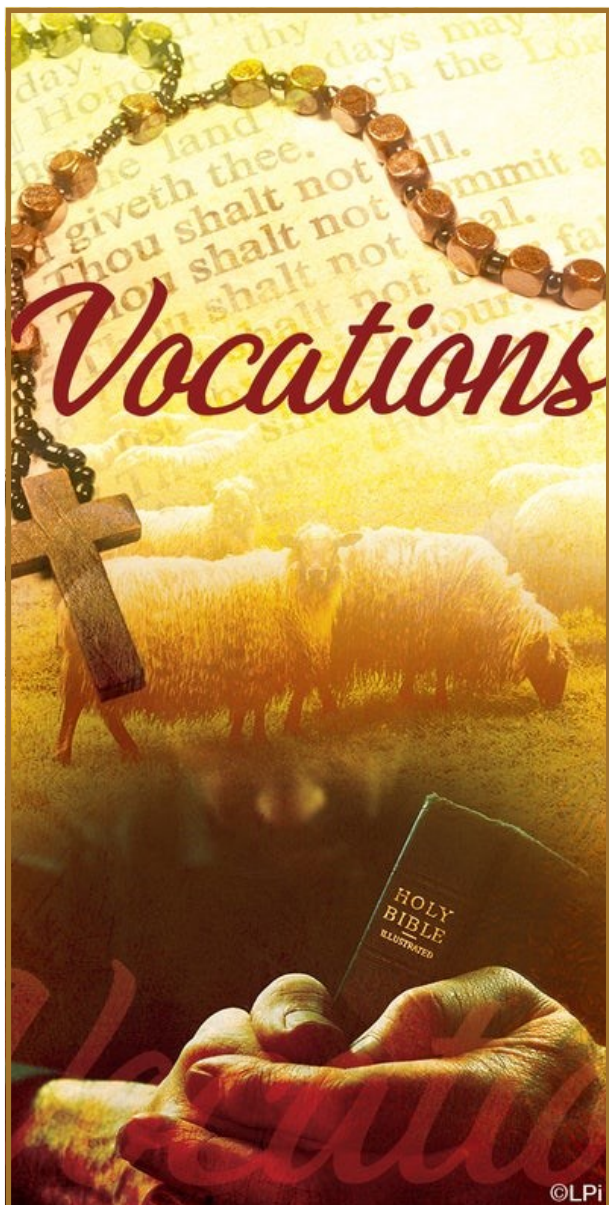
News and Events
