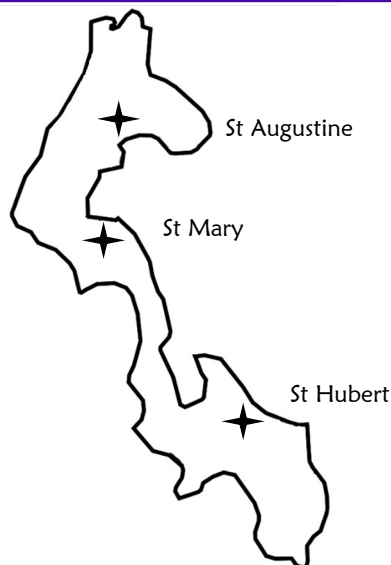

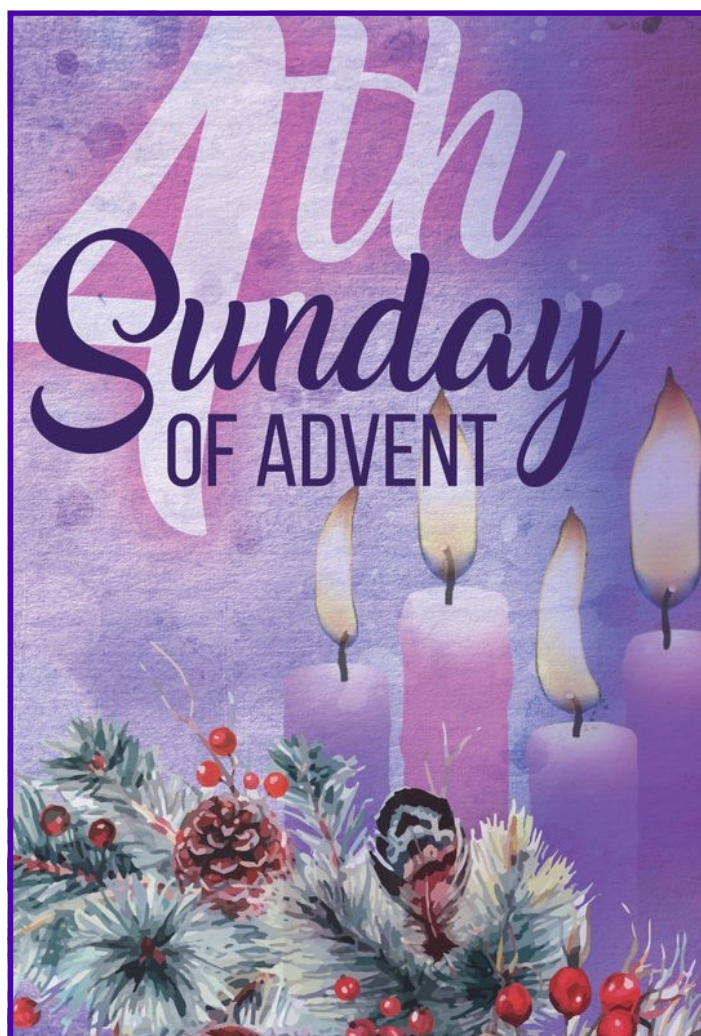

We close out the Christmas octave—the eight days following the birth of Jesus Christ—with a day honoring Mary as the Mother of God.

The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God is a liturgical celebration observed on January 1st and is a holy day of obligation.

By celebrating this solemnity, dedicated to Mary's motherhood, the Church highlights the significance of the Blessed Virgin's part in the life of Jesus, and emphasizes that He is both human and divine!
