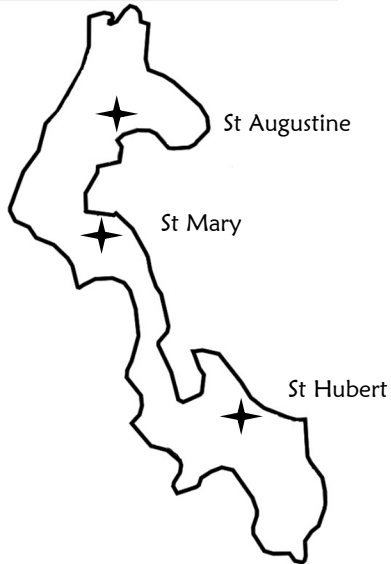

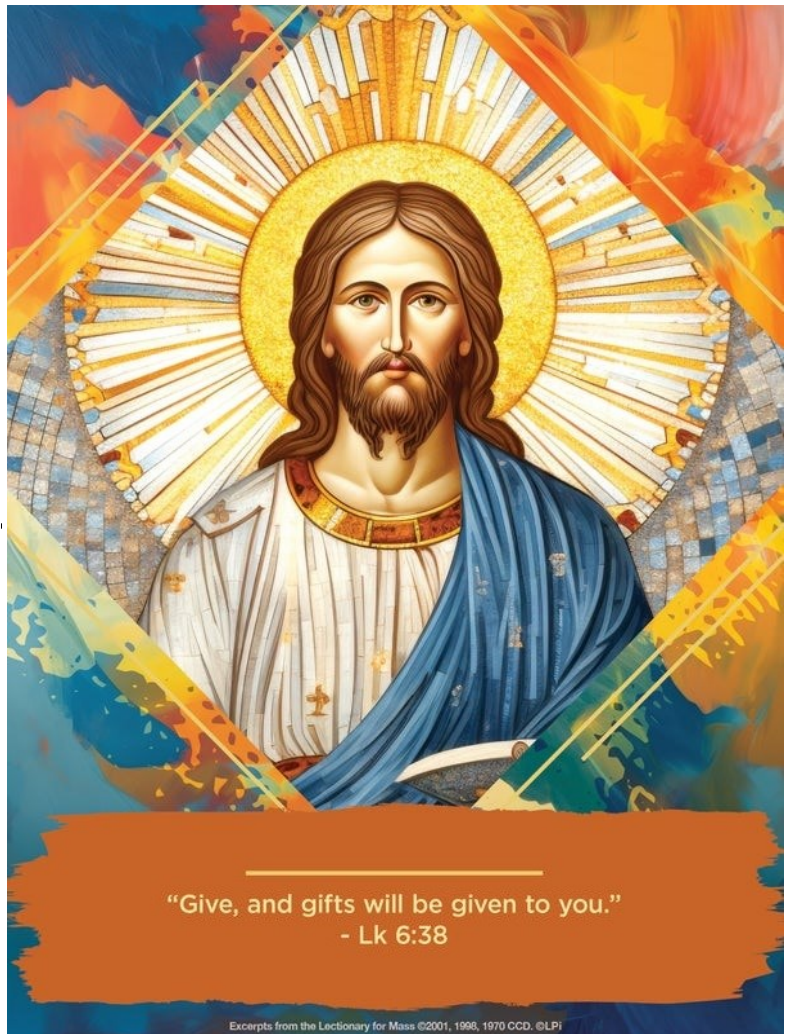

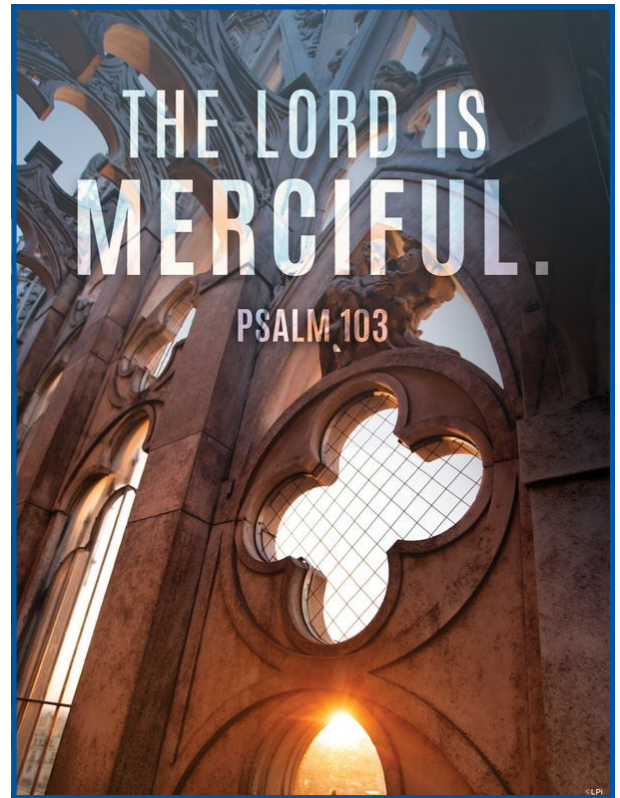
Sacraments

Baptisms

- ⌘ The next Baptisms are May 31
- ⌘ We schedule a maximum of 4 children per Baptism.
- ⌘ Call the parish office at 360-675-2303 for more information or to register for class.

Anointings:

- ⌘ Please call the parish office at 360-675-2303 on Wednesday - Friday from 10:00 am - 4:00pm to request an anointing or last rites. On Tuesdays, please call the St. Mary, Anacortes office number at 360-293-2101.
- ⌘ After 4pm Wednesday-Sunday, call the office at 360-675-2303 and listen to the message to receive the **emergency anointing or last rites only** phone number. *On any Monday*, please call another parish to request an anointing.



Tips & Etiquette

- ⌘ Confirm Confession dates/times and show up on time, so you won't feel rushed
- ⌘ Reflect upon the Examine of Conscience (copies are available in the parish office) prior to coming to Confession
- ⌘ Jot down any prayers you don't have memorized and reminders about what you plan to say
- ⌘ Be honest, succinct, and complete in your confession. Remember, you are confessing to God Himself, not to the priest.
