Kindly note: USED CLOTHING will not be accepted.

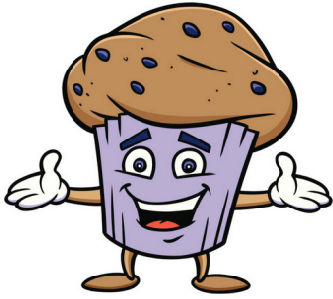
Wreaths: Fall, Thanksgiving, or Christmas wreaths will be accepted until November 2nd.

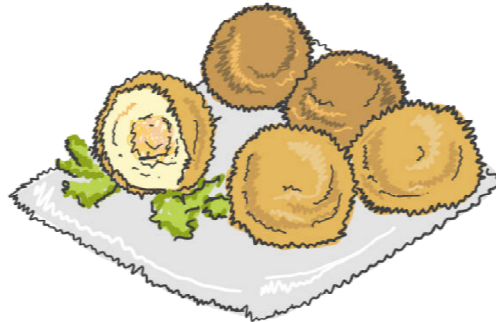

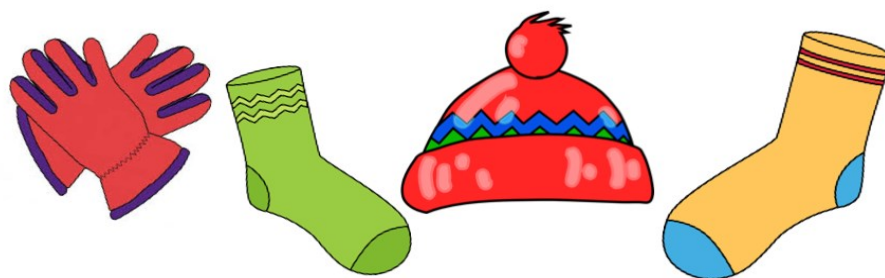
